CCD Committee Responsibilities

1. Review suggested topics for special collections that would address those noted by the member libraries, and suggest other areas of interest for further consideration
2. Review and be familiar with the approved Collection Development Guidelines for selecting digital resources to be added to the SLS regional digital library.
